THE INTER-AMERICAN COURT PRESENTS A HISTORIC COLLECTION OF MORE THAN 2000 AUDIO FILES OF ITS PUBLIC HEARINGS

San José, Costa Rica, February 1, 2019 – The Inter-American Court of Human Rights presents the *Audio Library of the Inter-American Court of Human Rights*.

On the past 28th of January, during the Inauguration of the Judicial Inter-American Year 2019, the President of the Court, Judge Eduardo Ferrer Mac-Gregor Poisot, officially announced the publication of the *Audio Library of the Inter-American Court of Human Rights*, a historical collection that comprises more than 2.000 audio files of the public hearings that have been held in the 40 years of the Court's existence.

The Audio Library, which is organized into 297 albums, contains a detailed description of the precedents of each hearing that has taken place in the framework of: contentious cases, advisory opinions, supervision of execution of judgments and provisional measures. It also contains keywords that facilitate the search. This new feature allows access and recuperation of the oral stage of the proceedings introduced before the Inter-American Court, thereby constituting an invaluable contribution to the institutional memory.
