## THE I/A COURT HR AND MERCOSUR'S IPPDH ANNOUNCE THE LIST OF INDIVIDUALS SELECTED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE SECOND EDITION OF THE INTERNATIONAL COURSE "COMPLIANCE WITH THE JUDGMENTS OF THE INTER-**AMERICAN COURT OF HUMAN RIGHTS AND PUBLIC POLICIES** FOR THEIR IMPLEMENTATION"

San José, Costa Rica, February 28, 2025. The I/A Court HR and the Mercosur Institute of Public Policies (IPPDH) announce the list of the individuals selected to participate in the second edition of the international course "Compliance with the Judgments of the Inter-American Court of Human Rights and Public Policies for their Implementation."

The second edition will be held with the support of the Ministry of Justice of Paraguay and the Attorney General's Office of the Republic of Paraguay.

Individuals were selected based on the criteria mentioned in the call for applications, after an exhaustive review of each of the 1,934 applicants from 25 countries.

## The selected individuals are:

- State agents or individuals who work in the legal representation of the states in Contentious Cases and/or Monitoring Compliance with Judgment before the Inter-American Court of Human Rights
- public officials in charge of implementing or executing the reparation measures ordered by the I/A Court HR
- public officials responsible for the design, direction, execution and evaluation of the reparations ordered by the I/A Court HR that may entail public policies
- public officials from national human rights institutions of the States Parties who have an impact, at the domestic level, on compliance with the reparations ordered by the I/A Court HR
- representatives of victims who are part of proceedings before the inter-American system for the protection of human rights
- inter-American defense counsel
- individuals from civil society and academics.

## Schedule:

- Online course lessons: March 12 to April 23, 2025.
- In-person week: May 5 to 9, 2025 (Asunción, Paraguay)

The international course aims to train and update key actors in the Americas on the various forms of reparation ordered by the Inter-American Court in its judgments







and on compliance by the State through the design and implementation of public policies with a human rights perspective.
