INTER-AMERICAN COURT OF HUMAN RIGHTS TRANSLATES KEY JUDGMENTS INTO ENGLISH AND PORTUGUESE THANKS TO THE SUPPORT OF SWEDEN

San José, Costa Rica, May 28, 2025 - The Inter-American Court of Human Rights, with the support of the Swedish International Development Cooperation Agency (SIDA), has made available on its website the translation of 14 judgments into English and 2 judgments into Portuguese, issued by the Court in 2022 and 2023. The documents were translated between January and December 2024.

Through the project "Institutional strengthening of the Inter-American Court of Human Rights to optimize its capacities - Phase III" a key contribution was made to the dissemination of the Court's jurisprudence in English and Portuguese, allowing the translation of a total of 15 judgments.

It is worth noting the importance of translating the Inter-American Court's decisions into English. Firstly, there are State parties to the American Convention that are English-speaking countries; secondly, there are other American States, including several in the Caribbean, which have not yet ratified the American Convention, and the language barrier is one of the main obstacles for them to learn about the Court's work.

Moreover, translation into English is fundamental to the harmonious development of international human rights law and to strengthen the increasingly fluid and constant jurisprudential dialogue with the European and African Courts of Human Rights, the human rights bodies of the United Nations, academia, international law research centers, among other key international actors.

The translation of the Court's judgments into Portuguese allows for an important rapprochement with the Portuguese-speaking public, especially the population of Brazil. This facilitates access by attorneys, judges, students and civil society organizations to the jurisprudence of the Inter-American Court in their native language.
