CORTE IDH TV BEGINS TRANSMISSIONS



San José, Costa Rica, June 13, 2023. On May 22, 2023, CORTE IDH TV, the Inter-American Court's new audiovisual platform began transmissions.

Like other Courts of the Americas and other International Courts, the Inter-American Court is taking another step towards the establishment of an **online audiovisual transmission service and a platform of on-demand audiovisual content** related to the Court's work. See [here](#).

Since 2020, the Inter-American Court has been implementing an Institutional Communications Plan, and this has resulted in new content leading to a more widespread dissemination of the Court's activities. The Court's YouTube Channel has become one of its main means of communication and has allowed the Court to produce relevant content for the dissemination of its work.

"Under the Court's open-door policy, today we are taking one more step towards communicating the work of the Court so that it will reach more people throughout the Americas. CORTE IDH TV, together with the Court's Training Center, will ensure that the Court's Case law with regard to the protection of human rights is known throughout the region," stated the President of the Inter-American Court, Judge Ricardo C. Pérez Manrique, during the first interview transmitted by the new television channel. See the interview [here](#).

The audiovisual content will be available to be shared, either by streaming or on the web platform of [CORTE IDH TV](#) content. The 2003 programming of CORTE IDH TV will include Court hearings, a cycle of interviews with judges and human rights defenders, and a series of reports entitled **Reparando Derechos** (Remedying rights) on the impact of the Court's case law on the life of the individual.

The channel will start live transmissions during gradually increasing time slots and will sign agreements with domestic courts of Latin America that have their own public television channels, the first of these being the television channel of the Supreme Court of Justice of Paraguay.
