

INTER-AMERICAN COURT OF HUMAN RIGHTS PUBLISHES ITS WEBSITE IN PORTUGUESE



Brasilia, Brazil, August 24, 2022. As part of the 150 Regular Session taking place in Brasilia, Brazil, the Inter-American Court launched the Portuguese language version of its website at https://www.corteidh.or.cr/index.cfm?lang=pt.

On the new website you will find all the information associated with the Inter-American Court's case law, press releases and institutional information translated into Portuguese. "This is a great opportunity for our Court to make the website of the Inter-American Court available to Brazilians in Portuguese, bringing us closer to the country and its people," said the President of the Inter-American Court, Judge Ricardo C. Perez Manrique.
