YOUTH CONCLUDE THE IV EDITION OF THE LATIN AMERICAN HUMAN RIGHTS SEEDBED

San José, Costa Rica, August 21, 2025. On August 8, the IV Edition of the "Latin American Human Rights Seedbed: Bringing the youth close to the Inter-American Court of Human Rights" (LATAM Seedbed), a regional initiative along with the Human Rights Center of the Law Faculty of University of Buenos Aires, the Rule of Law for Latin America Program of the Konrad Adenauer Foundation and the Training Center of the Inter-American Court of Human Rights, came to a close.

The LATAM Seedbed took place virtually from May 24 to August 8, 2025, through meetings and workshops led by experts on human rights and international justice. The main goal of the program is to consolidate a network of young university students from various countries in the region, to strengthen their knowledge of the functioning of the Inter-American Court of Human Rights and disseminate its jurisprudential standards.

In the fourth edition, 17 students from 12 countries in the region completed the program. The closing ceremony included the participation of Hartmut Rank, Program Director of the Rule of Law Program of the Konrad Adenauer Foundation; Leonardo Filippini, Director of the Human Rights Center of the University of Buenos Aires; and Pablo Saavedra Alessandri, Registrar of the Inter-American Court of Human Rights. During the ceremony awards were given to the best projects and diplomas were given to the graduates, who come from various countries in Latin America.
