



## **INTER-AMERICAN COURT OF HUMAN RIGHTS HELD ITS 179<sup>th</sup> REGULAR SESSION**

*San José, Costa Rica, September 9, 2025.* The Inter-American Court of Human Rights held its 179<sup>th</sup> Regular Session from August 18 to September 3, 2025. The session was hybrid, including both virtual and in-person activities. During this session, the Court held deliberations and hearings.

### **I. Public hearings on contentious cases**

The Court held two public hearings in the following contentious cases:

#### **a) *Case of Zuccolillo Moscarda v. Paraguay*<sup>1</sup>**

On August 21, the Court held a public hearing on the request for extension of the provisional measures in the cases of Barrios Altos and La Cantuta v. The Court approved orders on monitoring compliance with judgment in the following cases:

1. Case of Sales Pimenta v. Brazil
2. Case of Valencia Campos et al. v. Bolivia
3. Case of Guzmán Medina v. Colombia
4. Case of Córdoba v. Paraguay
5. Case of the Sawhoyamaxa Indigenous Community v. Paraguay.
6. Case of the Xákmok Kásek Indigenous Community v. Paraguay.

#### **VI. Other resolutions issued by the Court**

The Court issued a resolution regarding the application of Article 53 of the Rules of Procedure in the cases of Olivera Fuentes and the Inhabitants of La Oroya Community v. Peru.

On September 3, the Court held a public hearing on the request for extension of the provisional measures in the cases of Barrios Altos and La Cantuta v. Peru, in which it decided to ratify the measures of injunction issued by the President of the Court in the Resolution of July 24, 2025. The order is available [here](#).

##### **a. Meeting with the Association of Female Judges of Argentina (Asociación de Mujeres Juezas de Argentina, AMJA)**

On August 18, the Court held a meeting with a delegation from the Association of Female Judges of Argentina (AMJA), as part of an institutional visit to see the Court's facilities and strengthen their understanding of its internal operation.

The Court continued hearing several pending cases, monitoring compliance with several judgments and the implementation of provisional measures. It also addressed several administrative matters.
